- <u>FEE WAIVERS ARE AVAILABLE!</u> To see if you qualify for a test waiver, see the <u>SAT/ACT Fee</u> <u>Waiver Request Form</u> and turn it in to Ms. Aguilar in the College & Career Center

- College Board has identified <u>some</u> students as qualifying for SAT waivers. When logging in, those students will see a pop-up with waiver info PLEASE READ IT! (See next slide)

You may only waive the SAT, SAT Subject Tests, and ACT twice!



Private & Out-of-State Schools

Requirements vary by school (example: Arizona requires three years of lab science)

Check each school/major for specific requirements

Admissions testing requirements will vary by school

Private & Out-of-State Schools

The Common Application is often used; letters of recommendation are needed.

Highly selective private colleges and universities recommend a <u>minimum</u> of five (preferably six) academic courses each year.





- <u>-Requirements:</u> Application, Orientation, and self-assessment for English & Math

- -Honors Program 3.5 GPA required. The SAT is not required, but can help. Must have completed Algebra 2 ℰ Other A-G Requirements with a C or better.

 - Filing period: October 1- March 2
