

Quartz Hill High School 2024 Prom Packet & Permission Slip



Off-Campus Guest AND Underclassmen Guest Pass applications are due to the Activities Office by Friday, February 23. QHHS Juniors/Seniors may bring one approved guest to Prom. Guests must be approved prior to purchasing a ticket. Guest tickets must be purchased with their date's ticket. Once approved, the QHHS Junior/Senior will receive an email from Mrs. Estrada with an appointment to purchase the two tickets in the Student Store. *Webstore payments are not available for students bringing a guest.*

Prom Packet

- 1. All students must have a school I.D. to purchase tickets. A physical school I.D. for students and a picture (school/driver's license) I.D. for non-student guests is required to board the bus (no photos of IDs on phone accepted).
- 2. **PARKING LOT NOTICE:** All persons and vehicles entering this area are subject to search and the person in charge of the vehicle consents to the search of the entire vehicle and its contents with or without cause by school officials or law enforcement officers. Search may include all vehicle compartments and containers.
- 3. **CONSENT TO SEARCHES:** The district provides parking at school sites and at the District office for use by visitors, students and staff. By entering District parking lots, the person in charge of the vehicle acknowledges that bringing a vehicle onto District property constitutes consent to the search of such vehicle and its contents. School officials may also search students, students' property (including but not limited to backpacks and purses) or district property under the student's control when there is a reasonable suspicion that search will uncover evidence that the student is violating the law or District policies.
- 4. School buses will be used for transportation to and from Prom and you must ride on your assigned bus to and from Prom.
- Quartz Hill High School cannot be held liable for any service issues that arise from a malfunctioning bus. In the event that a problem occurs, every reasonable effort will be made to provide students with alternate transportation to the event in as quick a manner as possible. No refunds or partial refunds are guaranteed.
- 6. If you have any specific dietary needs, you must inform Mrs. Estrada in room 217 by March 20th.
- 7. There will be NO COAT CHECK at this year's event. Bring items to the event at your own risk. Students are solely responsible for all items brought with them to Prom, including purses, jackets, shoes, electronic devices, etc.
- 8. All rules and policies on the QHHS website are in effect.
- 9. The AVUHSD has a "Zero Tolerance" policy. This means NO drugs, drug paraphernalia, alcohol, or tobacco.
- 10. Parents or the person on the emergency card will be called to transport students home if violations of school policy and/or Education Code occur. As a result, seniors may not walk at graduation.
- 11. All guests attending Prom are the responsibility of the QHHS student with whom they are attending the event.
- 12. Any student who is subject to significant disciplinary action in the 2023-2024 school year will be ineligible to attend Prom.

13. All students will be searched before loading the buses and again at the venue. Administration reserves the discretion to make final judgments on items. The following items are not acceptable and will be confiscated by security guards at school and/or at the venue:

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TICKET SALES INFORMATION

Prom tickets will be sold at the Student Store during both lunches. To purchase a ticket, you must:

- Be a QHHS junior or senior
- Have a signed permission slip
- Have a physical QHHS ID card
- If bringing an off-campus or QHHS freshman/sophomore as a guest, you must purchase BOTH your ticket and your guest ticket at the same time (Guests must be approved through the Activities Office in the administration building.)

Students with significant disciplinary action in the 2023-2024 school year will be ineligible to attend *Prom.*

January 16 - March 1 | Early Bird Pricing

- Take advantage of lower pricing during this period.
- First-come-first-serve during lunches in the Student Store
- Only 20 tickets will be sold per lunch period; anyone still in line when the end-of-lunch bell rings will be sent to class
- QHHS Juniors and Seniors NOT bringing an off-campus or underclassman guest can buy tickets at this time
- Get your off-campus or underclassman guest approved EARLY and purchase yours and guest's ticket during this time as well.

March 4 - March 8 | GUEST SALES & Early Bird Pricing

- Priority sales will be given to QHHS Juniors & Seniors bringing approved off-campus or underclassman guests.
- As guest passes are approved, Mrs. Estrada will schedule the QHHS Junior/Senior to purchase tickets during a specific day/lunch this week at the early bird pricing.
- 20 people per lunch period will be scheduled; if the appointments are not filled, Juniors/Seniors not bringing a guest may also purchase during this week, first-come-first-served.

March 9 - March 20 | Regular Pricing (No ASB Discount Available)

- Appointments will be available to purchase tickets after school (beginning at 3:40 on regular days; 2:50 on flex days) from March 11-20, as needed.
- Announcement will be made the week of March 4 regarding days in which students can purchase tickets during this time period.
- If you cannot attend after school, a friend may purchase a ticket for you, provided they have your signed permission slip and ID Card. An individual may purchase tickets for up to 4 people.

Guest Passes & Ticket Sales

Juniors and Seniors can bring one guest to prom. The guest can be a QHHS freshman or sophomore, or an off-campus guest (under 21 years old). To bring a guest, you must fill out the guest packet and get it approved by Ms. Tiffany in the Activities Office by February 23rd. Once your guest is approved, you may purchase tickets. Tickets must be purchased together. Guest does not have to be present for ticket sales and their ID is not required since we will have a photocopy of it in their packet. *They must bring a physical ID on the day of Prom to get on the bus.*

Bus Labels

After purchasing your ticket and turning in your permission slip, you will receive a sticky label. Groups of students who wish to ride to Prom on the same bus must fill out their labels and stick them onto a sheet of computer paper. Submit your sheet to Mrs. Estrada in **room 217**. If you do not wish to ride the bus with a group, apply your individual label on a sheet of paper and submit to Mrs. Estrada. All labels must be turned in by the end of "B" lunch on Wednesday, March 20th. Sheets cannot contain more than <u>45</u> people, including guests.

Independent Study students: You can submit your label to Ms. Tiffany in the office by 3/20 or submit it with a group on campus. Every attempt will be made to accommodate your grouping request, but no guarantee is made. <u>Once submitted, changes cannot be made.</u>

Miscellaneous Information

- An ASB card discount is available to QHHS juniors and seniors only during early bird pricing. Underclassmen guests with ASB receive no discount.
- Tickets will be sold from the Student Store only.
- You may not sell or give away your ticket to another student.
- No refunds. No exceptions.
- Guest tickets must be purchased with their host. Cannot be done separately.
- **QHHS Juniors**: Prom Court paperwork will be available Feb 6 and due on Feb 15. Prom Court voting will take place Feb 29-March 1 and official Prom King and Queen voting will take place in April.

Prom Dress Code:

Attire is strictly formal. Only modest and age-appropriate clothing may be worn.

- No canes or chains, bandanas, head rags, or baseball caps allowed.
- No sheer/see-through material between mid-thigh and bust area. No exposed undergarments.
- **No** overly revealing body parts. (No bare midriff, no bare lower back, no plunging bust line, slits must be at the mid-thigh or lower, dress/skirt length cannot be shorter than mid-thigh.)

Inappropriate dress will result in a student or guest not being allowed to board the bus for Prom.
