- A. To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:
1. You must earn a **minimum of 10 points** from last semester's grades.
 - a. The first **4 points** must be from LIST I (unless you are a senior applying for membership in February or June).
 - b. The first **7 points** (including the 4 described in "a") must be from LISTS I & II.
 - c. The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II, or III).
 2. You must use **no more than 5 courses** to qualify.
 3. **No** CSF points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teacher assisting, courses taken on a pass/fail basis, and summer school courses.
 4. CSF points are granted as follows:
 - a grade of A = 3 CSF points.
 - a grade of B = 1 CSF point.
 - ***Note:** One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP, IB, or Honors course, **extra point can be added to a MAXIMUM of two classes only!** – do not add extra point to *all* AP, IB, Honors classes.
 - a grade of C = 0 CSF points.
 - a grade of D or F in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, **disqualifies** you from membership at this time.

- B. Also remember:
1. Semester membership is based on work done in the previous semester (college courses taken during that semester may be used)
 2. You must reapply each semester.
 3. Courses you may use are divided into LISTS I, II, and III. (Listed on the reverse side.)
